WALTHAM ESTATE MOTORCYCLE, MOPEDS & MOTOR SCOOTER PARKING PERMITS POLICY

A Motorcycle has more than a 50-cc engine size, and no more than 3 wheels.

A Moped has two (2) wheels, an electric motor or gasoline engine with a combustion chamber of between 50 and 125 cubic centimetres or less. Mopeds have pedals.

A Motor Scooter has two (2) wheels, an electric motor or gasoline engine with a combustion chamber of 50 cubic centimetres or less. A motor scooter does not have pedals.

An operator is defined as a person who drives or is in actual physical control of the vehicle.

The Registered Owner is defined as the person to whom the vehicle is registered as owner through the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Summary

The Waltham Estate Parking Permit Policy aims to ensure the fair, equal and consistent distribution of both residents parking permits and visitors permits on the estate. The aims of this policy are:

To provide a parking enforcement policy that reflects the parking enforcement needs.

To provide an effective, clear, and transparent parking enforcement service for the residents of the estate.

To ensure permits are distributed in line with tenancy or leasehold. obligations and that consistency in the distribution of permits is achieved.

To ensure the parking arrangements on the estate is monitored and periodically reviewed.

Contractor

The approved contractor for parking enforcement on the Waltham Estate is Smart Parking.

Scheme Operation Times

The enforcement scheme will be in operation 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, with the exception Christmas day,

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Parking Permit Document Requirements

For a Resident Parking permit, you will need:

- To live for a minimum of four nights on the Waltham Estate.
- A valid full UK driving licence registered to your address on the Waltham Estate.
- A valid certificate of motor insurance (cover notes for less than 30 days are not acceptable) showing your address on the Waltham Estate.
- Full vehicle logbook (V5) registered to your address on the Waltham Estate.
- Car tax or statutory off-road notice (SORN). The SORN must be registered at your address on the Waltham Estate. SORN's are permittable for a maximum of three months but the vehicle must have insurance and an MOT.
- A valid MOT certificate.
- A valid vehicle lease agreement showing that the vehicle is leased to your address on the Waltham Estate.

Residents Visitors Permits

Waltham Estate Residents' visitors will need to download the RingGo App on their mobile phone.

Use the location code as shown on the signage within the estate.

Rules

- 1. Motorcycles, mopeds, and motor scooters are permitted on the Waltham estate with an annual motorcycle permit.
- 2. Parking permits are limited to one permit per household. If a parking permit is revoked, another household member will not be issued with a permit during the revocation period.
- 3. All parking permit revocations last for six months.
- 4. Motorcycle permits are valid in motorcycle stalls only and motorcycles, mopeds & motor scooters are not allowed to park in car parking bays.
- 5. Motorcycle permits are available only to tenants/leaseholders and their authorised occupants.
- 6. Visiting motorcyclists are required to download the RingGo App.
- 7. Motorcycles, mopeds, and motor scooters parking permits are valid for one year and the owners are responsible for the purchase of their permit renewal. The Waltham Estate Housing Office is not responsible for sending out reminders.
- 8. Parking permits will only be issued to tenants or leaseholders who are not in rent or service charge arrears.



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- 9. Only Waltham Estate residents and their visitors are permitted to park on the Waltham Estate.
- 10. Visitors of Waltham Estate residents are not permitted to park up their motorcycles on the estate and then leave to go to work or on shopping trips etc. The parking permit of the tenant, leaseholder or any of their household members will be revoked if their 'visitor' abuses the Visitor Parking Regulations.
- 11. Resident parking permits may not be issued to residents who have been served a Notice of Seeking Possession, a Notice to Quit or who had any form of other legal action initiated against them or any persons in their household on any basis e.g. Nuisance etc.
- 12. Resident parking permits may not be issued if you are in debt to the Waltham Estate Resident Management Organisation for any reason e.g. outstanding court costs, rechargeable works and /or Section 20 invoices.
- 13. A parking permit will be revoked if the holder, a member of their household or any of their visitor's breach any of the Waltham Estate's road signs or road signage.
- 14. Abusive behaviour towards residents and staff from residents and/or their visitors will not be tolerated, and should any incidents occur,
- 15. any parking permit issued to the person concerned or members of their household will be revoked.
- 16. A parking permit will be revoked if a tenant/leaseholder, a member of their household or any of their visitors breach the Waltham Estate's Pet Policy.
- 17. A tenant's/leaseholder's permit will be revoked if any fly-tipping fine is not paid within two weeks of it being issued.
- 18. A tenant's/leaseholder's parking permit will be revoked if either they, a member of their household or any of their visitors cover up their vehicle registration number before entering or leaving the estate.
- 19. A parking permit will be revoked if, once brought to their attention, any of the parking permit holder's visitors continue to park their vehicle on the Waltham Estate if the vehicle does not have a valid MOT or if it is not taxed or insured.
- 20. Parking permits are issued to carers providing that the carer can provide an original copy of their Carers Allowance award letter. The carer cannot use the permit for their own personal use.
- 21. Tenants/leaseholders visitors can park on the estate for a maximum of
- 22. 70 days a year. The parking permit of the tenant/leaseholder will be revoked if the 70-day limit is breached.
- 23. Parking permits are valid for one year and the holders are responsible for the purchase of their parking permit renewal. The Waltham Estate Housing Office is not responsible for sending out reminders.
- 24. Parking on Waltham the Waltham Estate is on a first come first served basis. No parking bays are reserved.



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- 25. Any tenant/leaseholder who is found to be renting out parking bays on the Waltham Estate will have their parking permit revoked. Additionally, they will be reported to Lambeth Council for breaching their tenancy/lease agreement. They will also be reported for fraud to local law enforcement.
- 26. The Waltham Estate management reserves the right to amend the above regulations without notice.

Penalty Charge Notice Appeals

The Waltham Estate Housing Office does not handle penalty charge appeals.

Appendix 1

The cost of an annual motorcycle parking permit is £20, subject to annual review.

An additional fee of £10 will be charged if you change your vehicle at any time during the year.

The cost of a daily motorcycle visitor permit via the RingGo App is £4.50, subject to annual review.
